This year's Oyster Fling will feature fare prepared by Buoy One of Westhampton, live music, Chinese auctions, and the highlight of the evening, the Oyster Fling, which will give guests the unique and hands-on opportunity to participate in an activity that directly cleans Moriches Bay and helps further our mission.
